



IMT Des Moines Marathon No Parking/Road Closures

Here is a list of suggested travel patterns through downtown Des Moines that motorists are encouraged to follow in order to avoid traffic delays due to IMT Des Moines Marathon road closures on Sunday, October 15.

Northbound Traffic for Fleur Drive

East on Bell/Thomas Beck to SW 7th Street

North on SW 7th to Tuttle

West on Tuttle to 8th Street

North on 8th Street over the viaduct into the downtown business district

Southbound Traffic for Fleur Drive/MLK Jr Pkwy Jr Pkwy

East on Ingersoll/High to 9th Street

South on 9th across the viaduct to Park Avenue

West on Park to Fleur Drive

Northbound Traffic for Indianola Avenue/SE 1st - west

West on Indianola Road to SW 7th St

North on SW 7th St to Tuttle

West on Tuttle to SW 8th St Viaduct

North on SW 8th St Viaduct into the downtown business district

Northbound Traffic for Indianola Avenue/SE 1st - east

North on SE 1st Street to Scott Avenue

North on SE 4th Street or SE 6th Street to MLK Jr Pkwy Jr Pkwy

Eastbound Traffic for Grand Avenue & Ingersoll Avenue

North on 56th to either Ingersoll, I-235 eastbound

Westbound Traffic for Grand Avenue & Ingersoll Avenue

North on 31st to either Ingersoll, I-235 westbound, 42nd Street

Westbound Traffic for MLK Jr Pkwy Jr Pkwy north Downtown Business District

North on 7th or 8th Street to Mulberry Street

Westbound on Mulberry to 9th Street viaduct south over MLK Jr Pkwy Jr Pkwy

Fleur will remain open until 8 a.m. and then close at Bell, George Flagg Parkway ML King and at Ingersoll until 2 p.m.
